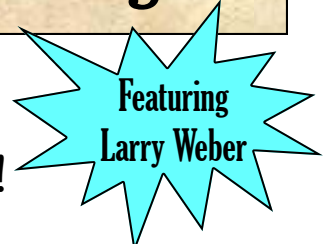




# Minnesota Master Naturalist Volunteer Training Program
